



## **How to Leave a Gift in Your Will**

### **Where your gift will go**

### **How to add a gift to your will**

Consider what type of gift you'd like to leave:

- A share of your estate. Also known as a 'residuary legacy', this is a percentage of what remains of your estate after all other gifts and expenses have been paid. Many people choose to add a percentage of their estate as this means our gift remains in proportion to what they want to leave to family and friends.
- A specific sum. This is a gift of a set amount of money, also known as a 'pecuniary legacy'.

### **Talk to your solicitor**

If you don't already have a Will, you should visit a solicitor to have your Will drawn up. We can't recommend a solicitor, but you can find one in your local area by contacting the Law Society in England (020 7242 1222), Scotland (0131 226 7411) or Northern Ireland (028 9023 1614).
